Pan Caribbean Sugar Company Limited</i>	The Defendant was charged under: 1) The Waste Water Sludge Regulations, Reg. 6(1) for discharge of trade effluent into the environment without a licence; 2) The Natural Resources Conservation Authority Act s. 12(1)(a) for discharge of trade effluent into the environment without a licence; and 3) The Wild Life Protection Act s. 11 for discharge of trade effluent into a river containing fish.	<u>Decision(s)/Order(s):</u> Relisted for mention, 2017 December 10. 2.	<i>R v. Nordie Smith</i>	The Defendant was charged with the operation and construction of a wastewater treatment facility without a permit contrary to The Natural Resources Conservation Authority Act s. 9(2)	<u>Decisions/Order(s):</u> Trial, Monday, July 9, 2018
3.	<i>R v. Neville J. Melvin</i>	Breach of the s. 3(1) of the Wild Life Protection (Hunters Licences) Regulations	<u>Decisions/Orders granted:</u> A plea of guilty was entered and a fine totaling twenty-seven thousand dollars was or a total of forty-four days was ordered
4.	<i>R v Harish Lachmandas et al (17 Dillsbury Avenue)</i>	Breach of section 12 of the Natural Resources Conservation Act, 1991 – The defendants discharged Sewage Effluent into Waters, on the Ground or into the Ground at Millsborough Gully, behind Wiggan Loop, Barbican Mews	<u>Decisions/Orders granted:</u> Mention, Thursday, June 21, 2018
5.	<i>R v. Trevor Dunkley</i>	Breach of the Natural Resources Conservation Act, 1991 s. 9(2). Defendant was charged for operating a dispensing and storage petroleum facility without an environmental permit.	<u>Decisions/Orders granted:</u> Mention, Thursday, June 14, 2018
