PUBLIC NOTICE

The Town and Country Planning Authority & the Natural Resources Conservation Authority (TCPA/NRCA) under the Town and Country Planning Act & the Natural Resources Conservation Authority Act and the Government Town Planner (GTP), being responsible for planning and environmental approvals, hereby remind members of the public that, as at 2nd April 2010, all plans or drawings submitted to the National Environment and Planning Agency (NEPA) with offices at 10 & 11 Caledonia Avenue, Kingston 5, being part of an application to be considered under the Town and Country Planning Act and the Natural Resources Conservation Authority Act, must be prepared by, or certified by, a locally registered professional (Architect or Engineer or Land Surveyor). The professional must hold a current certificate of registration under the Architects Registration Act, the Professional Engineers Registration Act of 1987 or the Land Surveyors Act.

The Authorities and the GTP wish to emphasize that all architectural drawings must be certified by a Registered Architect, all engineering drawings must be certified by a Professional Engineer and all subdivision plans certified by a Commissioned Land Surveyor.

Plans or drawings submitted that do not meet these criteria will not be accepted.
