

Procurement Notice for Provision of Security Guard Services

Scope: Provision of Security Guard Services for 24 months (2019-2021)

The National Environment & Planning Agency (NEPA), an executive agency existing under and by virtue of the executive agencies act, 2002, requires a Contractor to provide security services for properties and facilities located at 10, covering personnel, equipment, vehicles, buildings and 15A Caledonia Avenue, Kingston 5.

Security services will include, but not confined to perimeter security, designed to exclude intruders from the boundaries; static security at specific entrance and exit points of NEPA offices; preventive security, including where necessary search of vehicles, workers and visitors; security dispersal to minimize theft and vandalism of property and controlled security to deal with unforeseen situations involving hostility or violence within NEPA Offices; enforcement security including parking regulations.

This is an online Tender where tenderers will only be made available and accepted via electronic Government Procurement Portal (**www.gojep.gov.jm**). No hard copies of bids will be accepted and there will be no physical tender box for drop-off of tender documents.
