Application for an Exemption under Section 22 of the Wild Life Protection Act for being in Possession of the whole or any part of a Protected Animal or Protected Bird

The form must be completed in full. The administrative fee is JA\$24,000.00.

The completed form should be returned to the National Environment and Planning Agency (NEPA) at 10 Caledonia Avenue, Kingston 5, c/o Mr. Peter Knight, Chief Executive Officer.

The completed form and the Natural Resources Conservation Authority's (NRCA) recommendations will be submitted to the Minister responsible for the Environment.

NB. The Minister may order the confiscation of such animal/bird if the application is not granted.

All birds in Jamaica except the birds in the 2nd schedule to the Act are protected.

A copy of the Schedule to the Wild Life Protection Act with a list of all protected animals is attached to this form.
