THE ENDANGERED SPECIES (PROTECTION, CONSERVATION AND REGULATION OF TRADE) ACT, 2000**THE ENDANGERED SPECIES (PROTECTION, CONSERVATION AND REGULATION OF TRADE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2000**

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 53 of the Endangered Species (Protection, Conservation and Regulation of Trade) Act, 2000 and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Endangered Species (Protection, Conservation and Regulation of Trade) (Amendment) Regulations, 2000 and shall be read and construed as one with the Endangered Species (Protection, Conservation and Regulation of Trade) Regulations, 2000 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations).

2. Regulation 1 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by—

(a) renumbering the regulation as paragraph (1);

(b) inserting next after paragraph (1), as renumbered, the following as paragraph (2)—

"(2) These Regulations shall not apply to a species for which a national quota has been determined pursuant to section 15 (1) (f) of the Act.".

3. Regulations 2 and 3 of the principal Regulations are hereby amended by inserting next after the words "issue of a permit" the words "or certificate, as the case may require,".

4. Paragraph (a) of regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the words "import or re-export permit" and substituting therefor the words "import permit or re-export certificate".

5. Regulations 12 and 15 of the principal Regulations are hereby amended by deleting the words "re-export permit" and substituting therefor the words "re-export certificate".

6. Paragraph (1) of regulation 17 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the words "Re-export permit" and substituting the words "Re-export certificate".

7. The Second Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting Form 1 therein and substituting therefor the following—
