THE ENDANGERED SPECIES (PROTECTION, CONSERVATION AND REGULATION OF TRADE)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2002

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 53 of the Endangered Species (Protection, Conservation and Regulation of Trade) Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Endangered Species (Protection, Conservation and Regulation of Trade) (Amendment) Regulations, 2002 and shall be read and construed as one with the Endangered Species (Protection, Conservation and Regulation of Trade) Regulations, 2000 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations).
 - 2. Regulation 1 (2) of the principal Regulations is amended—
 - (a) by deleting the words "not apply to a species" and substitute therefor the words "apply to any species"; and
