- 1. This Order may be cited as the Natural Resources (Prescribed Areas) (Prohibition of Categories of Enterprise, Construction and Development) Order, 1996.
- 2.—(1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2), except under and in accordance with a permit issued by the Authority, no person shall, from and after the 1st day of January, 1997, undertake any of the categories of enterprise, construction or development specified in Column A of the Schedule, within the area specified in Column B thereof.

(2) Sub-paragraph (1) shall not apply to any category of enterprise, construction or development which was in existence before the date specified in that sub-paragraph.
