THE WILD LIFE PROTECTION ACT

THE WILD LIFE PROTECTION (HUNTERS RETURNS) REGULATIONS, 1999

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Natural Resources Conservation Authority by section 14 of the Wild Life Protection Act, and with the approval of the Minister, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as The Wild Life Protection (Hunters Returns) Regulations, 1999.

2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), every holder of a hunter's licence shall, on or before the 31st day of December in each year complete and submit to the Natural Resources Conservation Authority a return of bird shooting information in the form set out in the Schedule.

(2) Where the holder of a hunter's licence fails to submit a return in accordance with paragraph (1) the Natural Resources Conservation Authority shall charge a fee to be known as a late processing fee, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (3).

(3) There shall be payable in respect of any return submitted during the period 1st day of January to the 31st day of May in any year a late processing fee as follows:-

(a)	in respect of the period 1st day of January to the 31st day of March in any year	\$2,000.00
(b)	in respect of the period 1st day of April to the 31st day of May of each year	\$5,000.00

(4) A holder of a hunter's licence who refuses or neglects to submit the return required under paragraph (1) by the 31st day of May in any year shall not be granted a hunter's licence in relation to the season next following that date.

3. Every holder of a hunter's licence shall retain the feathers on one wing of each bird shot for inspection by a Game Warden or such other officer appointed pursuant to section 13 of the Act.

4. Any person who fails to comply with the provisions of regulation 3 commits an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction in a Resident Magistrate's court to a fine not exceeding Two Thousand Dollars.

5. The Wild Life Protection (Hunters' Returns) Regulations, 1991 are hereby revoked.

FOLLOWING THE CLOSURE OF THE GAME AREA DURING SEASONS THAT EXCEED A LATE PROCESSING FEE WILL BE APPLIED DURING THE FOLLOWING PERIOD AS FOLLOWS: LEGALITY TO MARCH 1, 2000 AND 11:59 PM ON DECEMBER 31, 2000, THE LATE PROCESSING FEE WILL BE \$10.00 FOR AN ANNUAL HUNTER'S PERMIT; LEGALITY TO MARCH 1, 2001 AND 11:59 PM ON DECEMBER 31, 2001, THE LATE PROCESSING FEE WILL BE \$15.00 FOR AN ANNUAL HUNTER'S PERMIT; AND LEGALITY TO MARCH 1, 2002 AND 11:59 PM ON DECEMBER 31, 2002, THE LATE PROCESSING FEE WILL BE \$20.00 FOR AN ANNUAL HUNTER'S PERMIT. NO LATE PROCESSING FEES WILL BE APPLIED AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2002. NO LATE PROCESSING FEES WILL BE APPLIED FOR ANNUAL HUNTER'S PERMITS ISSUED BY MAIL OR BY REGISTERED MAIL TO PO BOX 307 EUGENE, OREGON.
