The examinations will be conducted in the following locations: St Ann, Kingston and Negril. Prospective candidates should give attention to the Agency's examinations dates listed below:

EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS

To participate in the examination, candidates must:

· Be at least 18 years of age

- · Be able to read and write
- · Present a valid JLSS Certificate
- · Present proof of payment for the Examination Fee
- Present valid photo I.D. (Driver's Licence, National I.D., Passport) <u>OR</u> a passport-size photograph certified by a Justice of the Peace)
